SECTION 1

INTRODUCTION

1-1. MANUAL SECTIONS.

Motor coach living is truly an enjoyable way to travel. You have probably chosen the FMC 2900R Motor Coach because you want a life style that provides some of the luxury you were accustomed to at home, coupled with mobility. The FMC motor coach will provide you this way of life with many years of satisfaction, but to achieve this requires a thorough understanding of the operation of every system in your coach. We have designed this manual to give you that understanding.

Your owner's manual is divided into seven looseleaf main sections. Each section is tabbed and indexed for easy reference, and pages can be replaced easily for updating and insertions. This manual covers floor plans, "A" and "J". Plan "A" coaches have the dinette installation, while plan "J" coaches have a sofa-bed with removeable pedestal mounted tables. Coaches built to plan "A" have the letter A as part of the coach serial number (S-4-08-A-00250); coaches built to plan "J" have the letter J as part of the coach serial number (S-4-08-J-00251).

SECTION 1 is the introduction - you are reading it now.

SECTION 2 describes the FMC warranty and service policy. The warranty and subsequent owner's registration tear-out cards are in this section, and the procedure for obtaining the service you deserve as explained.

SECTION 3 provides a complete list of FMC's nationwide network of service facilities for your motor coach.

SECTION 4 provides instructions for coach operation and maintenance.

SECTION 5 describes the living area of your motor coach, and gives you helpful tips toward gaining maximum pleasure from each comfort-oriented feature.

SECTION 6 contains specifications and data covering the units contained in the coach.

SECTION 7 provides information on state laws regulating motor coaches, safe driving hints, sources of additional helpful information, travel check-lists, and other travel and camping information.

1-2. ILLUSTRATIONS.

Illustrations supplement the text of this owner's manual to assist you in fully understanding the complete FMC 2900R Motor Coach. We have identified illustrations by a figure number adjacent to the illustration. The figure numbers are keyed with each section and are used in the text when referring to the illustrations.

As a means of becoming acquainted with the contents of your owner's manual and your motor coach, we suggest that you briefly scan the pages to see what the FMC motor coach is all about. Then, read your owner's manual from cover-to-cover.
