DESCRIPTION

The furnace thermostat mounted on the bathroom wall, adjacent to the refrigerator, is often struck by the freezer door, refrigerator door, or both doors when they are opened. To protect the thermostat from damage, a door bumper (RVD 5101810) has been added to the wall just to the right of the thermostat.

INSTALLATION

Locate bumper so that it protects the thermostat when either or both of the refrigerator doors are opened. Bumper screws into wood panel adjacent to the thermostat.

OWNERS

If your coach is not equipped with such a bumper, make a request for it through your dealer. Allow ample time for delivery since the parts will be supplied to dealers only upon request by you.
